If you only go out twice this stretch: last two days of the **Lorain County Fair** this weekend (Wellington, over Sunday), then the **Cleveland National Air Show** or **Cleveland Oktoberfest** for Labor Day. Everything else is gravy. North Ridgeville readers: **Northeast Ohio Vet Fest** is still on Saturday at Victory Park – hometown, don't sleep on it.

This is Issue 01 of Festival Gazette, an independent weekly for Northeast Ohio. We do the same job a flyer wall does, only you can scan it: name, when, where, who, cost, why go, and a source. Church halls, ethnic picnics, county fairs, wine walks, the big city weekends. Rust flag means must-see. We do not invent hours or prices. If a field is thin, the organizer has not published it clearly – go to the source. Grown-up nights this issue: Nikki Glaser and a sold-out wine tasting this weekend; wine walk and Wine & Dine on Labor Day; Crocker Park, Sips & Swigs, Hops for Hope, and the Cleveland Comedy Festival later in September.

WHO tells you who the outing is for:

Everyone – good for family and adults. Bring kids or don't; it works either way.

Family – a kids or family outing. Built around children, or the day's main draw is for families.

Adult – grown-up. 21+, wine or beer is the point, late night, or no kids focus.

MUST SEE is a rust flag, not a ranking of joy. It means: if you have one tank of gas, start here.

Not a public drop-in: Evening in Ohio City is Sat Aug 29, but tickets are \$200 for a trolley home-tour fundraiser. We left it off the cards. Burning River Fest is not on the 2026 calendar; Great Lakes ran a one-day Beer & Music Fest in early August, already over.
